DEBRIS DROP-OFF EXTENDED THROUGH SUMMER

Thanks to the Community Foundation of Northeast Michigan, the County of Alpena, in partnership with the Charter Township of Alpena, is happy to announce that the countywide debris drop site will operate through August. Brush, branches, limbs, and tree debris may be brought to a parcel located off of Airport Road (map attached) on the listed days/times, listed below. This location will be monitored by person and camera. Private companies and units of government will not be able to utilize the site for disposal of debris they collect, instead the space will be limited for private citizen use only. Individuals should not drop any debris at this site outside of these designated times/dates. Violators will be prosecuted.

Hours of Operation

Monday, June 23, July 28, and August 4 & 18 from 4PM until 6PM

Friday, July 11 & 18, and August 15 from 11AM until 1PM

Saturday, June 7, July 12 & 19, and August 9 & 23 from 10AM until 1PM

Sunday, June 15, 22 & 29, July 20 & 27, and August 3 & 31 from 12PM until 2PM

Location will be closed in the event of rain

The county will have limited availability to collect brush and tree debris on Friday June 13 & 27. The elderly, disabled, or those facing financial hardship will be prioritized. This service is not guaranteed. Debris and limbs must be stacked near the road at the end of your drive to qualify.
