FIRE FIGHTER and/or EMTs or MFR

Position Type: Part- Time
Job Classification: Non-Exempt

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Performs firefighting activities including driving fire apparatus, operating pumps and related equipment, laying hose, and performing fire containment, extinguishments and overhaul tasks. (Fire Fighters only)
- Performs emergency medical service activities including providing medical treatment as allowed by the individual or licensure level of the department. (MFR and EMTs only)
- Participates in training, attends classes that pertain to licensure in firefighting, emergency medical, hazardous materials, and related subjects.
- Operates radios and other communications equipment.
- Carries out duties in conformance with Federal, State, County, City and Local laws, ordinances and protocols.
- Assist in developing plans for special assignments such as emergency preparedness, hazardous communications, training programs, firefighting, hazardous materials, and emergency aid activities.
- Adhere to Township and department policies and procedures.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be 18 years or older at time of employment and be a high school graduate or have a GED equivalent.
- Paid on call firefighters must be certified as a FFI, ICS, NIMS by the Michigan Fire Fighter Training Council within twelve (12) months of hire.
- Medical First Responders and Emergency Medical Technician must hold current license.
